Reports

1. Minutes for June were read and approved. See written report that follows.
2. Financial report for June 1 through August 31 were read and approved. See written report that follows. Current Balance: \$4283.92 for months of June-August 1122.10 expenses. Income \$335.00
3. Membership-63% of homes have paid this year. Membership drive was in May but you may pay at any time during the year.

Old Business

1. Landscape-Estimates for seasonal planting are from Basnight Land and Lawn, Gosman and Associates and Newell Lawn and Landscape . See written estimates from August 27th Executive Board Meeting. Garden club members will still weed and Don Spears will continue to mow. Executive board recommends Gosman and Associates. Residents voted to accept the recommendation of the board.
2. City Services requested for overgrown foliage and resurfacing of neighborhood streets. A board member contacted the homeowner of the foliage at the corner of Downing and Back Rds. Homeowner unsure who owns the bushes and didn't have time to do it. Homeowner has since passed away. City will not trim the bushes as it is private property. Joyce sent letter regarding potholes and surface of streets to the city. See letter that follows. Response from the city says "they have been done"-some potholes have been filled and some resurfacing has been done-not sure if recently or when they did it a few

years ago. City recommended for the 2020-21 resurfacing schedule-Northwood-from Kensington Way to Downing Dr. and Drury from Charing Cross to Downing Drive.

3. Civic Conversations for the First Precinct at Central Library attended by Joyce Monaghan and Lisa Hess. Lisa Hess gave a report from the meeting. Report follows.
4. Storage-As mentioned in earlier meetings, we are in need of a storage area for Tunbridge Station Civic League. Currently, board members are storing them at their private homes. Ongoing project. Two locations have been considered. Near pumphouse or behind the brick sign at the front entrance.
5. Letter from City requesting participants in the Steering committee for the Chesapeake Public Schools was received by the board. See city website for application for this committee.
