1. Meeting Rooms-Towne Bank has provided this room form many years at no charge. The normal cost for the room is \$100. This year, we put in our request on Sept 2<sup>nd</sup>. Joyce put in a call to check on dates. None of the requested dates were available. Tunbridge Station had back-up options for the meetings. According to Towne Bank, none of those dates are available either. Tunbridge Station checked with the Chesapeake Public Library. CPL is not an option, the library closes at 8 pm and can only be booked 2 months at a time. Tunbridge Station is looking into additional options for meetings including Chesapeake Public Schools-either BRI or HMS. There is a fee for the use of

the room and there is a 4 hour minimum and insurance is required. A member suggested the Mason Lodge across the street. Sgt Parker, 1<sup>st</sup> Precinct administrator, will assist in exploring the possibility.

2. Elections of Officers-Joyce is not seeking reelection and Elsie is running unopposed and was reelected. Toni is seeking a replacement. The board thanked Joyce for her service to the neighborhood.
